The Partnership is voluntary and free of charge - but binding





Barriers to green procurement

Why?

- → Focus on low short-term price
- → Missing/unclear political or leadership decision
- → Lack of environmental competences in the purchasing department
- Lack of knowledge of where relevant and up-to-date requirements can be obtained
- Lack of control of compliance with environmental requirements that are put out to tender
